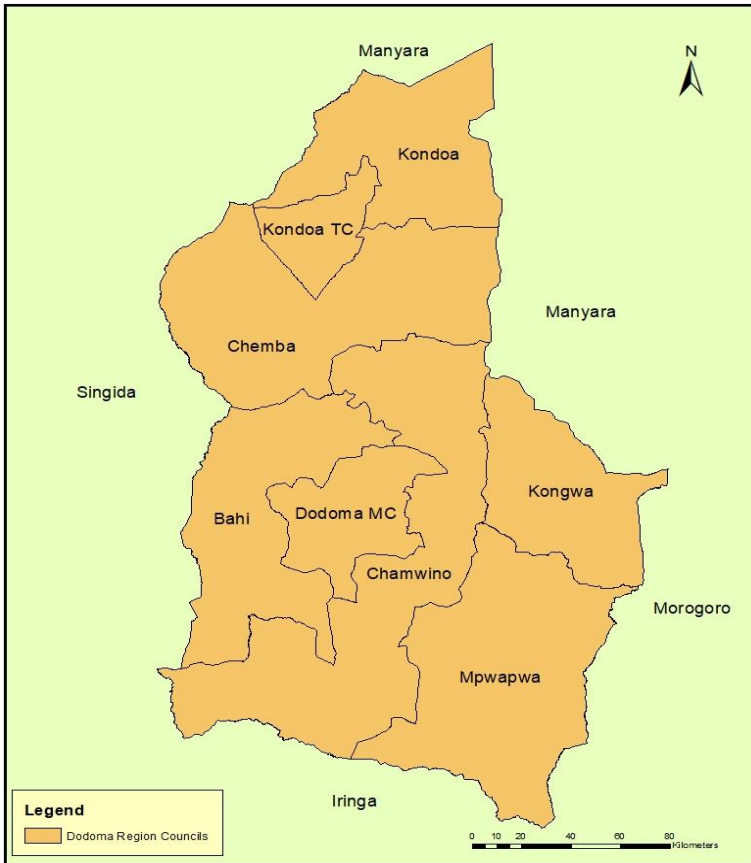

DODOMA REGION, ADMINISTRATIVE BOUNDARIES BY COUNCIL



Dodoma Region covers a total area of 41,311 sq km, equivalent to 4.4 percent of the total area of Tanzania's Mainland with 947,303 sq km. Out of available regional land, 40,741.7 sq km is land area while 569.3 sq km is land covered by water. This report has considered Dodoma Region, as an economic territory where transactions of goods and services took place.

Preface

The Dodoma Regional Gross Domestic Product (RGDP) measures the value of goods and services produced during a year and also shows the trend of growth of economic activities in the region between one year and another.

Dodoma RGDP is an important economic indicator that will be used in planning and coordinating economic development of the region. For the year 2022, Dodoma RGDP was 5,418,844 million shillings, where the Agriculture Sector contributed 39.8 percent, Industry and Construction 28.0 percent and Services Sector 32.2 percent. In comparing performance of RGDP by councils, Dodoma City Council has led by 33.5 percent while Chemba District Council contributed 5.9 percent which was the smallest compared with other councils.

In addition, this report shows the average per capita income of the Dodoma region as well as the average per capita income of the councils.

The methodology used in the compilation of RGDP followed the rules and guidelines provided by the United Nations Statistics Division for the compilation of National Accounts known as "United Nations System of National Accounts (2008 SNA)".

The use of SNA enables countries to prepare and compare their GDP figures with those of other countries around the world since the method of compilation is the same. The result of the Dodoma Regional Gross Domestic Product (RGDP) is presented at the Regional and Council levels. Similarly, Dodoma RGDP, at current prices, have been prepared in 2022 and included information for the year 2018-2022.

In addition, the Dodoma RGDP is a benchmark valuable economic information which will also be used as the reference in the preparing Dodoma RGPD for the coming years. The report also shows the challenges encountered during the preparation of the Dodoma RGDP and the way forward. The Regional Commission's Office and the National Bureau of Statistics Office will address those challenges for the purposes of improving future production of Dodoma RGDP.

This report concludes the joint work between Dodoma Regional Commission's Office and National Bureau of Statistics.

The completion of RGDP program, two activities were involved which are data collection and compilation process. The Regional Commissioner's Office coordinated

data collection of goods and services produced from various economic activities in the region. While, the National Bureau of Statistics provided National Accounts Experts who compiled the Dodoma RGDP. The methodology used is internationally accepted.

The National Bureau of Statistics expects that this information will be an important resource for planning and preparing Dodoma regional development plans.

1.0 Introduction

Dodoma Regional Gross Domestic Product report is a joint work between the National Bureau of Statistics and the Dodoma Regional Commissioner's Office. The process of compiling the report started in May 2023 with a training workshop on data collection techniques, analysis, and developing a work plan for the compilation of Dodoma RGDP. The working arrangement was as follows:

- Regional Commissioner's Office was responsible for coordinating and supervising data collection exercise covering all economic activities in the region, and;
- The National Bureau of Statistics was responsible for preparation of data collection tools, sampling frame as well as providing technical expertise on the RGDP compilation.

2.0 Objective

2.1 Main Objective

The main objective of Dodoma Region GDP estimates is to provide a vital economic indicator to be used as an input in planning for the regional development programs. It is anticipated that; the compiled Dodoma regional GDP estimates will be used to improve the Regional and District development planning processes.

2.2 The Specific Objectives

The specific objectives for compilation of Dodoma Regional GDP estimates were:

- (a) To collect data, compile, analyse and interpret Dodoma Region and Councils GDP estimates by economic activity.
- (b) To calculate Per capita GDP at regional and council level.

3.0 Benefits of Dodoma Regional GDP

Regional GDP data provides a useful information for planning and policy making. The Regional GDP results provides essential data for planning development and improve policy formulation because it can;

- a) Provide a base for greater understanding of the Regional economic performance, growth and sectoral performance;
- b) Provide a sound basis for monitoring and evaluation of economic development trends;
- c) Support central government's ability to target regional development programmes, including further development and implementation of FYDP and SDGs at regional and district levels;
- d) Provide a more robust basis for economic decision-making by region, districts and private sectors;
- e) Provide effective information base for public debate and community understanding of regional economic development;
- f) Provide benchmark data for addressing specific issues such as poverty reduction and industrialization (processing units of agricultural products into integrated producer schemes);
- g) Provide data that can be used to explore potential areas for investment at regional and district levels; and
- h) Open economic ventures by sectors and draw attention for technical know-how, movements and integrated industrialization process in the region.

4.0 Scope and Coverage

The administrative boundaries of Dodoma Region and the respective Councils, have been treated as economic territories for GDP compilation within which transactions of goods and services take place. The methodology used in the compilation of RGDP followed the rules and guidelines provided by the United Nations Statistics Division, known as "United Nations System of National Accounts (2008 SNA)".

The Dodoma RGDP report is compiled based on economic activities that is classified according to UN International Standard of Industrial Classification (*ISIC*). The economic activities involved are:

- a) Agriculture;
 - i. Crops;
 - ii. Livestock;
 - iii. Forestry;
 - iv. Fishing;
- b) Mining and quarrying;
- c) Manufacturing;
- d) Electricity;
- e) Water;
- f) Construction;
- g) Wholesale and Retail Trade; Repairs
- h) Transport and Storage;
- i) Accommodation and Food services;
- j) Information and Communication;
- k) Finance and Insurance;
- l) Real Estate;
- m) Professional, scientific and technical activities;
- n) Administrative and support service;
- o) Public administration and defense;
- p) Education;
- q) Human Health and Social Work;
- r) Arts, entertainment and recreation; and
- s) Other service activities.

In accordance to the ISIC Rev 4, the economic activities are also classified into three sectors namely:

- i. Agriculture (Crops, Livestock, Forestry and Fishing);
- ii. Industry and Construction (Mining and quarrying; and Manufacturing, Electricity, Water and Construction); and
- iii. Services (Wholesale and retail trade; Repairs, Accommodation and Food services, Transport and Storage, Information and Communication, Finance and Insurance, Real Estate, Professional, scientific and technical activities, Public administration and defense, Education, Human Health and Social Work, Arts, entertainment and recreation and Other service activities).

To a large extent, the economy of Dodoma Region depends on agriculture, especially the cultivation of food and commercial crops. Crops produced in large quantity in this region include maize, sorghum, brush millet, rice, sunflower and grapes.

5.0 Methodology

5.1 Regional GDP measurement approaches

The methodology used for the compilation of RGDP followed the rules and guidelines provided by the United Nations Statistics Division for the compilation of National Accounts, 2008 SNA manual known as "United Nations System of National Accounts (2008 SNA)". In addition, RGDP was compiled based on the value of goods and services produced excluding production costs including taxes and excludes subsidy on production.

5.1.1 Bottom-up Approach

The method of building up regional estimates from local enterprise data is known as the 'bottom-up' approach. It involves using data on production of goods and services produced at Council level. The Dodoma Regional Commissioner's Office coordinated data collection for the compilation of RGDP.

5.1.2 Top-down Approach

The method of using production of goods and services at national level (*Top-down Approach*), is used if the detailed production of goods and services collected at Council level is not sufficient. It involves distributing the GDP across regions using various indicators specified by type of economic activity in order to obtain the GDP of the region.

5.2 Compilation Procedures

There are three approaches for compilation of Gross Domestic Product namely; production, income and expenditure. These approaches are also applicable in the compilation of RGDP. Usually, the estimated value of GDP compiled using the three procedures should be the same.

Regional GDP by Production Approach is the value of goods and services produced minus the costs of intermediate consumption used in producing goods and services at the prices of the relevant year, including taxes and less subsidies used in production

Using income approach, RGDP is estimated by summing up compensation of employees, gross operating surplus, and taxes less subsidies on production.

Regional GDP by Expenditure Approach is derived by adding up the purchases that are made for final consumption, gross capital formation and exports less imports.

Dodoma RGDP was compiled using Production Approach due to availability of more reliable data on production of goods and services compared to the data available for Income and Expenditure Approaches.

The challenge of using Expenditure Approach in estimating Dodoma RGDP was mainly lack of information on imports and exports between the regions. In addition, RGDP compilation using income approach was a challenge due to weak data on consumption of fixed assets used in the production of goods and services. Dodoma RGDP was obtained by aggregating councils GDP, that is summation of all councils GDP is equal to the Regional GDP.

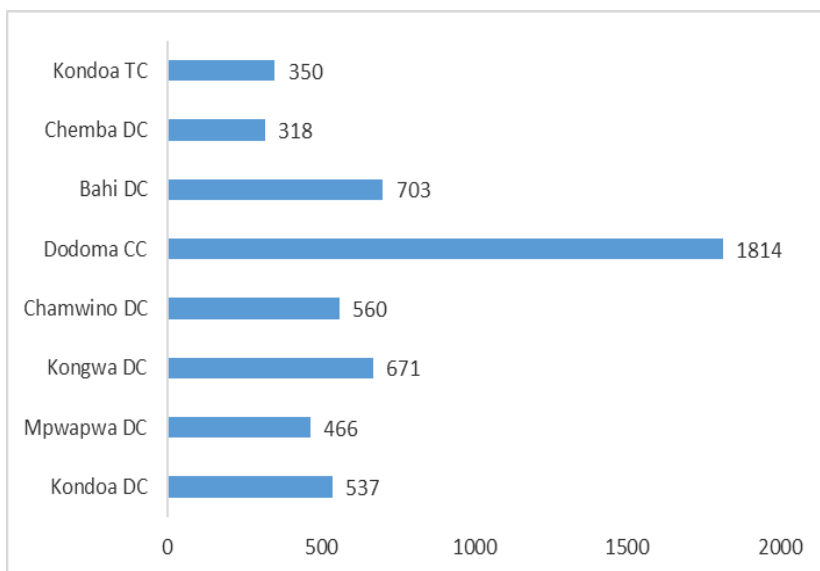
6.0 Key findings

Dodoma RGDP was compiled based on administrative boundaries of the respective Councils in the Region. In each Council, key indicators including total GDP, per capita GDP, and contribution of economic activity to RGDP are analysed.

6.1 Dodoma Regional GDP

In 2022, the Dodoma RGDP at current prices was 5,418.9 billion shillings. Dodoma City Council had the highest GDP worth 1,814 billion shillings while Chemba District Council had the lowest GDP of 318 billion shillings (Chart No. 1). In the period between 2018 and 2022, the Dodoma RGDP increased by 1,675,829 billion shillings. The largest increase was between 2019 and 2020 which was 714,187 billion shillings, while the smallest increase was between 2020 and 2021 of 269,505 billion shillings.

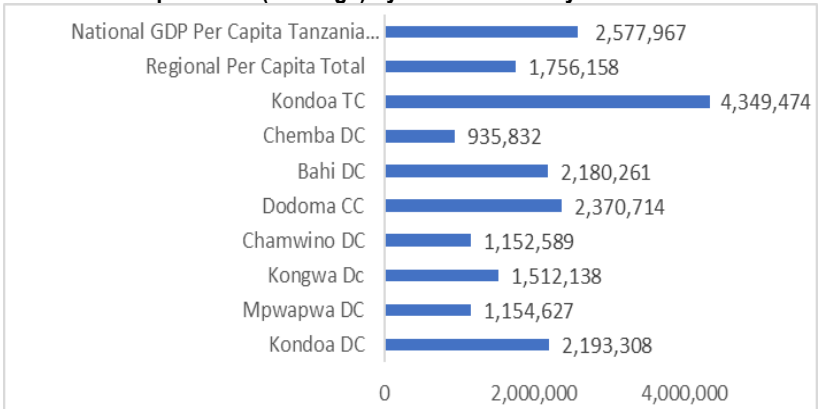
Chart 1: Dodoma RGDP at Current Prices (TZS.Billion), 2022



6.2 Per capita RGDP

In 2022, Dodoma regional Per Capita GDP at current prices was 1,756,158 shillings, which is lower than per capita GDP of Tanzania Mainland (2,577,967 shillings). Further, per capita GDP of Kondoia Town Council was higher (4,349,474 shillings) than that of Tanzania Mainland (2,577,967 shillings) and Dodoma region (1,756,158 shillings). During the year under review, the lowest per capita GDP of 935,832 shillings was recorded in Chemba District Council (Chart 2).

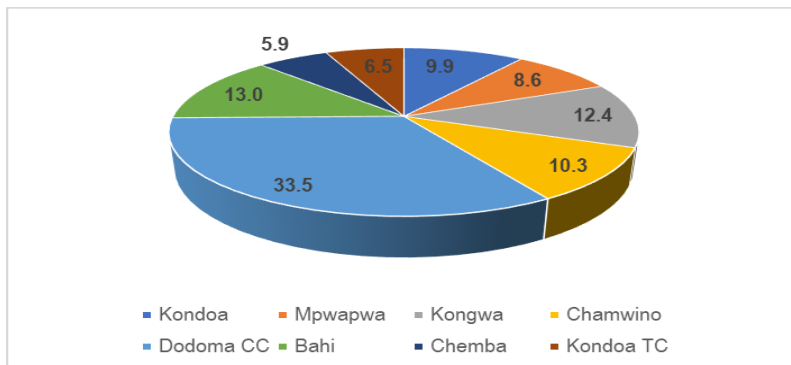
Chart 2: Per capital GDP (Shillings) by Council for the year 2022



6.3 Share of Councils to the RGDP

In 2022, Dodoma City Council contributed the lion share (33.5 percent) to the RGDP was 33.5 percent higher compared to other District Councils. In addition, Chemba District Council had a small contribution of 5.9 percent to the RGDP (Chart No. 3).

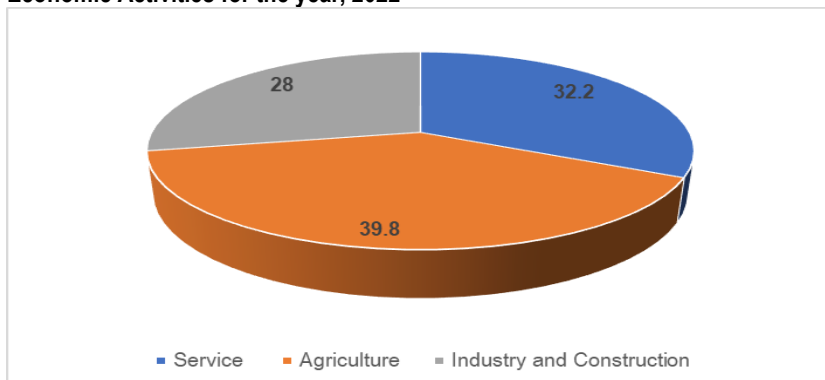
Chart 3: Share of Council to Regional Gross Domestic Product for the year 2022



6.4 Share Regional Gross Domestic Product by Broad Economic Activities, 2022

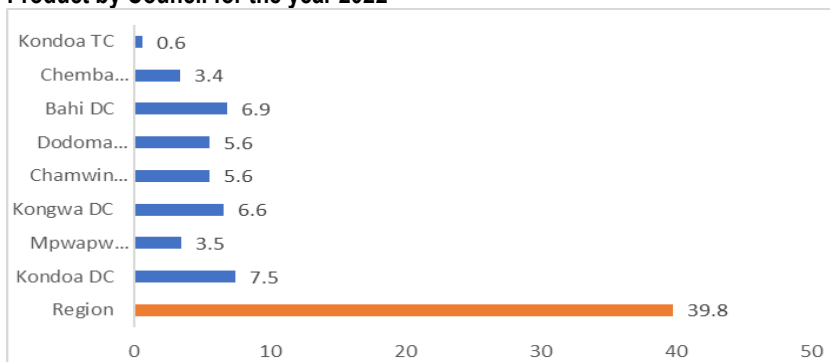
The 2008 SNA classify economic activities into three broad groups namely Agriculture, Industry and construction and Services. In 2022, Agriculture activities accounted for the largest share of 33.9 percent to the RGDP, followed by Service activities (32.2 percent) and Industrial and Construction activities which contributed 28.0 percent. (Chart No. 4).

Chart 4: Share of Dodoma Regional Gross Domestic Product by Broad Economic Activities for the year, 2022



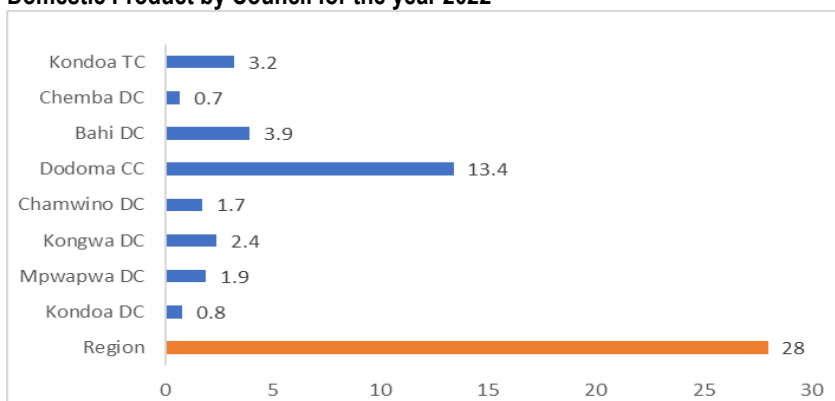
Agriculture activities in Kondo District Council recorded the highest share of 7.5 percent to the RGDP. In addition, agricultural activities in Kondo Town Council recorded the smallest share of 0.6 percent to RGDP in 2022. (Chart 5).

Chart 5: Share of Agriculture Sector to Dodoma Regional Gross Domestic Product by Council for the year 2022



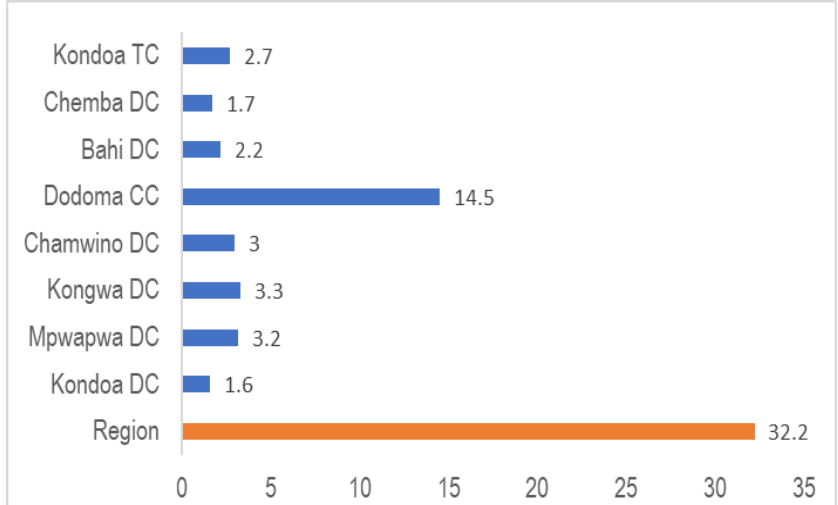
Industry and Construction activities in Dodoma City Council recorded the largest share of 13.4 percent and Chemba District Council contributed the smallest (0.7 percent) to RGDP in 2022 (Chart 6).

Service activities in Dodoma City Council recorded the largest share of 14.5 percent and Kondoa District Council contributed the smallest (1.6 percent) to RGDP in 2022 (Chart 7).

7.0 Challenges and Way-forward

7.1 Challenges

The challenges encountered during the compilation of Dodoma RGDP program include: -

- Insufficient statistics of key statistics on production of goods and services in the councils and lack of detailed income and expenditure information in the financial reports of the businesses;
- Inadequate statistical awareness among stakeholders regarding importance of keeping proper records and use of statistical information.
- The negative attitude of some respondents assuming that information requested would be used for tax purposes.

7.1 Way Forward

To address the challenges above, the following areas are proposed to be improved during preparation of the next RGDP.

- The Dodoma RGDP 2022 is the first report to be produced after the region became the official Capital City of Tanzania. It is therefore recommended to ensure continuous preparation of RGDP figures for the coming years assessing trends of economic development in the region;
- RGDP report should be disseminated to various stakeholders at different levels so as their feedback can be used to improve the next RGDP;
- To sign the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Dodoma Regional Commissioner's Office and the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS), to ensure availability of quality data for compilation of RGDP.
- The Regional Commissioner's Office and NBS should establish a deliberate training program for data collection coordinators regarding RGDP data requirements at regional and council's level.
- Continue with statistical awareness programmes to the public on the importance of timely submission of data required for compilation of RGDP, and

-
- To establish a budget at the Regional Commissioners's Office and respective councils for compilation of RGDP annually.

Annex 1: Concept and Definitions

National Accounts definitions

Basic price

The basic price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any tax payable, and plus any subsidy receivable, by the producer as a consequence of its production or sale. It excludes any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer.

Compensation of employees

Compensation of employees is defined as the total remuneration, in cash or in kind, payable by an enterprise to an employee in return for work done by the latter during the accounting period.

Consumption of fixed capital

Consumption of fixed capital is the decline, during the course of the accounting period, in the current value of the stock of fixed assets owned and used by a producer as a result of physical deterioration, normal obsolescence or normal accidental damage.

Gross Domestic Product (GDP)

The production measure of Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is derived as the value of output less intermediate consumption plus any taxes less subsidies on products not already included in the value of output.

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at current prices

Gross domestic product (GDP) at current prices is GDP at prices of the current reporting period. Also known as nominal GDP.

Gross Domestic Product (GDP) at constant prices

Gross domestic product (GDP) at constant prices refers to the volume level of GDP. Constant price estimates of GDP are obtained by expressing values in terms of a base period.

Gross operating surplus

This residual item is output at producer's values, less the sum of intermediate consumption, compensation of employees, and taxes on production and imports net of subsidies. It is approximately equal to accounting profit before the deduction of depreciation, direct taxes, dividends, and interest paid and bad debts, and before the addition of interest and dividends received.

Intermediate consumption

Intermediate consumption consists of the value of the goods and services consumed as inputs by a process of production, excluding fixed assets whose consumption is recorded as consumption of fixed capital.

Gross Output

Output is defined as the goods and services produced by an establishment, excluding the value of any goods and services used in an activity for which the establishment does not assume the risk of using the products in production, and excluding the value of goods and services consumed by the same establishment except for goods and services used for capital formation (fixed capital or changes in inventories) or own final consumption.

Producer price

The producer's price is the amount receivable by the producer from the purchaser for a unit of a good or service produced as output minus any VAT, or similar deductible tax, invoiced to the purchaser. It excludes any transport charges invoiced separately by the producer

Purchaser price

The purchaser's price is the amount paid by the purchaser, excluding any VAT or similar tax deductible by the purchaser, in order to take delivery of a unit of a good or service at the time and place required by the purchaser. The purchaser's price of a good includes any transport charges paid separately by the purchaser to take delivery at the required time and place.

Subsidies

Subsidies are current unrequited payments that government units, including non-resident government units, make to enterprises on the basis of the levels of their production activities or the quantities or values of the goods or services that they produce, sell or import.

Taxes on production and imports

Taxes assessed on producers in respect of the production, sale, purchase and use of goods and services, and which add to the market prices of those goods and services. This includes sales tax, local authority rates, import and excise duties, fringe benefits tax, and registration fees, such as motor vehicle registration, paid by producers.

Value-added

Value added represents the contribution of labour and capital to the production process (i.e. after the costs of bought-in materials and services have been deducted from the total value of output).

Establishment

Establishment is an enterprise, or part of an enterprise, that is situated in a single location and in which only a single productive activity is carried out or in which the principal productive activity accounts for most of the value added.
